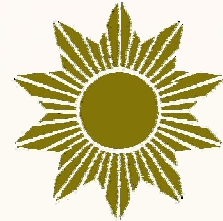


## 2005 PENLEY ESTATE CONDOR SHIRAZ CABERNET SAUVIGNON

**89 pts** "Ruby-red. Ripe cherry and plum aromas are liberally dosed with vanillin oak spice. Supple in texture, with juicy red and dark berry flavors, soft tannins and a late-arriving note of candied licorice. This gained weight with air, picking up luscious blackberry and cassis on the back. A refreshingly bitter cherry pit note adds interest to the finish of this suave midweight."
