88 pts “Medium ruby-purple in color, the 2010 Omrah Pinot Noir gives fragrant warm cherry and baking spice aromas with notes of milk chocolate, grated mace and coffee. Medium to full bodied, it offers generous cherry and raspberry flavors with high acidity and a medium level of silky tannins, finishing clean with good persistence. Drinking now, it should keep to 2015.”
