





## 2014 LEEUWIN ESTATE SIBLINGS SAUVIGNON BLANC SEMILLION

WINEMAKER: Paul Atwood

R E G I O N: Margaret River, Western Australia

VARIETALS: Sauvignon Blanc (68%), Semillon (32%)
MATURATION: 40% for 4 months in seasoned French oak
ANALYSIS: 13.0% alc/vol | 7.01 g/L TA | 3.13 pH

#### VINTAGE NOTES:

Pruning was completed in the middle of a very wet and windy September, with above average rainfall. Early spring was very windy, rainy and cool. Weather improved though October and November; bouts of wind and rain continued between periods of fine and sunny days. December was generally fine and warm. January was warm, with slightly above average daytime temperatures; February in contrast had slightly cooler than average daytime temperatures. A fabulous vintage with excellent weather conditions for developing and maintaining the delicate flavors of the white fruit.

#### WINEMAKING:

The grapes were picked, crushed and left on skins for around six hours prior to gentle pressing. The cold settled juice was then racked and inoculated with pure yeast cultures, with a portion barrel fermented and the remainder fermented in stainless steel followed by 40% of the wine maturing for four months in older French oak barrels.

### TASTING NOTES:


Bright and aromatic, the nose features finger limes, lemon flesh, guava and black pastilles. A savory thread is also present highlighted by nougat, cardamom and nettles. The palate is tight with subtle texture led by lemon and grapefruits. Hints of spice through the middle, combines with bright and integrated acidity.
