92 pts “Containing approximately 50% Cabernet Sauvignon and 20% Merlot, the 2004 The Galvo Garage has a deep garnet-brick color, a ripe, expressive mocha and spice nose, and hints of mulberries, creme de cassis, toast and Nutella. Rich, full bodied and mature in the mouth, it has a solid backbone of crisp acid and medium-firm finely grained tannins, finishing long. Delicious now, it should keep another 3-5 years+.”

90 pts “A proprietary blend of Bordeaux varietals, the inky/blue/purple-tinged 2004 The Galvo Garage (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, and Cabernet Franc) is a backward effort offering notes of black currants, sweet cherries, licorice, and underbrush. It is a structured, austere, but concentrated wine that will benefit from 2-3 years of cellaring, and keep for 12-15.”
