Review Summary



91 pts “The 2005 The High Trellis Cabernet Sauvignon was aged for 9 months in French and American oak. It is opaque purple-colored with an attractive perfume of cedar, spice box, cassis, plum, and black currant. This is followed by a medium-to full-bodied, structured wine with moderate tannin, ripe flavors, and lively acidity. It has 2-3 years of aging potential but can be enjoyed now.”

87 pts “Dark ruby. Ripe plum and kirsch aromas are deepened by hints of espresso and dark chocolate. Fleshy dark berry and cherry flavors are framed by supple tannins, with notes of black tea and underbrush introducing a dryish quality to the wine. Finishes on a note of bitter cherry, with good length.”
