90 points "Bright and lively, with snap behind the effusive tropical fruit and citrus flavors. The open texture lets the flavors sail on beautifully."

90 pts "Light gold color. Candied ginger, honey, pear nectar and anise on the nose. Quite pliant on the palate, with lush orchard fruit flavors and hints of honeycomb and jasmine tea. A solid, firmly built viognier, with no excess fat or looseness of texture, problems that afflict too many New as well as Old World viogniers today. Finishes on a dry note of apricot pit, with good lift.'
