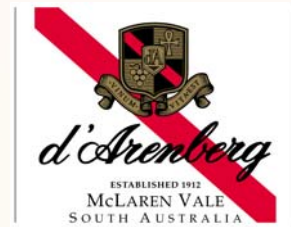


## 2005 d'ARENBERG THE LAST DITCH VIOGNIER

**90 points** “Bright and lively, with snap behind the effusive tropical fruit and citrus flavors. The open texture lets the flavors sail on beautifully.”

**90 pts** “Light gold color. Candied ginger, honey, pear nectar and anise on the nose. Quite pliant on the palate, with lush orchard fruit flavors and hints of honeycomb and jasmine tea. A solid, firmly built viognier, with no excess fat or looseness of texture, problems that afflict too many New as well as Old World viogniers today. Finishes on a dry note of apricot pit, with good lift.’
