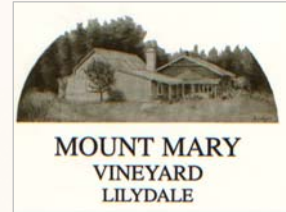




2005 MOUNT MARY PINOT NOIR
