









2006 d'ARENBERG THE CUSTODIAN GRENACHE

WINEMAKER: Chester Osborn

R E G I O N: McLaren Vale, South Australia

VARIETALS: Grenache

MATURATION: 12 months in new and older American & French oak barriques

ALCOHOL: 14.5% alc/vol

BACKGROUND:

In 1959, Francis d'Arenberg (d'Arry) Osborn began bottling d'Arenberg wines under the now famous Red Stripe label. Today, d'Arenberg is the keeper of nearly 1/3rd of all of McLaren Vale's old Grenache bush vines. d'Arry has now celebrated 65 consecutive vintages, with consistent critical acclaim of their coveted Grenache-based wines.

WINEMAKING:

Winemaker Chester Osborn guides the finest small-batch Grenache parcels from the vintage through the gentle 'Demoisy' crusher, into open fermenters and then into 19th century basket-presses. Natural minimal processing ensures maximum flavor which results in a harmless deposit in the bottle. This wine will benefit from extended bottle aging and decanting.

TASTING NOTES:

Fragrant Grenache notes of violets, ripe red fruits, spice, licorice and mulberry characters are apparent immediately, while and earthy potpourri notes develop as the wine opens up. The medium-bodied palate is fleshy with a concentrated array of red berries, dark sweet plums, strawberries and spice. This wine is perfectly balanced with fruit weight, tannins and acidity.

A century on, the estate has grown to 345 acres, and the mantle now rests with fourth-generation winemaker Chester Osborn.
