









# 2006 PENLEY ESTATE CONDOR CABERNET SAUVIGNON SHIRAZ

WINEMAKER: Kym Tolley

R E G I O N: Coonawarra, South Australia

VARIETALS: Cabernet Sauvignon (55%), Shiraz (45%)

MATURATION: 14% new French oak and 13% new American oak

ALCOHOL: 15% alc/vol

### VINTAGE NOTES:

Budburst was early with dry, warm spring weather resulting in early flowering. Summer was dry, with warm to hot days and cool nights. Approximately half way through vintage, the weather changed to mild, warm days and cool nights slowing the ripening period. The fruit hung on the vine longer which intensified the flavors, tannins and colors of the red varieties.

### WINEMAKING:

The complexity behind Penley Estate's Condor wine is the result of blending the two varieties and using a range of oak to produce a style that highlights the traditional (Shiraz) and the contemporary (Cabernet Sauvignon) grapes of Coonawarra.

### TASTING NOTES:


The Condor symbolizes Penley Estate's determination, energy and quiet persistence towards winemaking excellence. The 2006 Condor Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz is a rich wine with soft, lingering blackberry, chocolate and pepper spice aromas. A full bodied style, the palate has generous ripe berry and savory notes framed by velvety tannins. Drink now or cellar up to seven years for additional complexity.

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
