92 pts “Despite some slightly raisiny notes, this wine also displays some exotic floral aromas, then bold flavors of stone fruit and chocolate. It’s full bodied without seeming heavy at all, ending long, with savory plum and mocha shadings.”

Finishes with very good grip and a lingering note of smoky minerals. This improved with air, which suggests that it will repay patience.”
