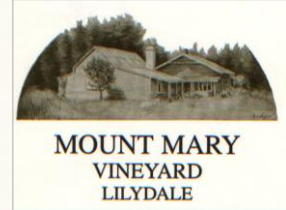


2008 MOUNT MARY PINOT NOIR

Review Summary



94 pts “Light, crystal-bright crimson; a super-elegant wine right in the heartland of Mount Mary pinot noir; the bouquet is fragrant, with perfumed red fruits, the silky palate with those fruits complexed by some precisely judged savory characters giving length.”

93 pts “Pale red. High-pitched aromas of strawberry, raspberry, blood orange and spicecake, with an intense floral overlay. Light-bodied and precise, offering sweet red berry and rose pastille flavors and notes of bitter cherry and allspice. Very pure and precise, with excellent finishing punch and lingering notes of singed orange and flowers. This wine is made in a old school Burgundy fashion, with no cold soak and a relatively hot fermentation.”
