



2010 JASPER HILL EMILY'S PADDOCK SHIRAZ

Review Summary



95+ pts “Medium to deep garnet-purple colored, the 2010 Emily’s Paddock Shiraz Cabernet Franc has lifted cassis and black plum notes with an undercurrent of blackberry preserves, menthol, tree bark, underbrush, chocolate and salami plus a whiff of chocolate box. The medium to full-bodied palate is superbly structured with a medium to firm level of grainy tannins and refreshing acid supporting the taut, generous fruit, finishing long, with a savory character coming through. Still a little young, give it another 2-3 years in bottle at least and drink it to 2026+.”

95 pts “Light, clear crimson-purple; perhaps due to the restrained alcohol, the cabernet franc component plays a more important role than it has done in some prior vintages, introducing aromas of violets, and dried tobacco on the palate; here fine tannins provide the structure for a very stylish wine.”

93 pts “Opaque ruby. Deeply pitched blackberry and blueberry aromas are complemented by notes of licorice and cracked pepper. Offers an array of dark fruit and spice flavors that are braced by tangy acidity. Rich but lively, with excellent finishing clarity, cut and sweet persistence. I’d give this youthful, very promising wine at least another five years of bottle age.”
