91 pts “Very light color, although the hue is bright; the floral bouquet is the bellwether for a palate that has greater depth of fruit than the bouquet would suggest; soft red cherry and a dash of plum have balanced savory tannins on the finish. A valiant effort from the 40-year-old vines.”
