88 pts “Light gold. Fresh pear and nectarine on the nose, with a touch of lemon pith adding lift. A juicy, taut midweight that offers lively orchard fruit and honeydew flavors complemented by a buttery nuance. Anise and bitter peach pit notes build on a spicy, clinging finish.”

“The 2010 Stickybeak Chardonnay is a pale light golden yellow in color. First aromas are intense, peppery and nutty – very pleasant. My initial sip is smooth and almost creamy with tastes of peach, nectarine and cantaloupe. No oakyness or butter as one would expect from a chardonnay, more citrusy and crisp with a ridiculously long finish. This is a super lively and fresh Chardonnay. I think this wine pair excellently with strong flavor fish like Salmon or heady cheeses like gorgonzola.”
