89 pts “This 2009 Chianti is a pleasant blend of Sangiovese, Merlot, Syrah and Colorino that was aged for eight months in French oak barrels. Even with the addition of Syrah and Colorino, the color of this Chianti is a medium-deep ruby. It has cherry-berry aromas, with cola notes, medium berry flavors, touch of sweet spice, 13% alcohol, firm tannins and good length through the finish with just a trace of bitterness.”

89 pts “Bright red. Intense red cherry aroma joined by delicately spicy red berry nuances. A bit harder and tougher in the mouth, with bright red fruit flavors firmed by high but harmonious acidity. Finishes fresh, clean and moderately long. I love this wine's juiciness; just a little more fruit and I would have scored it higher. The name Cerro del Masso was the original name of Alberto Antonini's father's first wine so he has kept it in his honor.”
