93 pts “Rich and full-bodied, to be sure, but looks as if it may have dodged the worst of the heat in '08; the bouquet, in particular, has an appealing mix of blackcurrant and cedar, and there are pleasingly savory elements on the palate that pick up the message of the bouquet. All up, a very commendable wine with years on its side.”
