92 pts “Light straw-green; the relatively warm vintage has aided the near riotous expression of tropical fruits on the scented bouquet, joined by ripe citrus on the palate; the flavors linger on the aftertaste.”

88 pts “Pale straw. A highly aromatic nose displays scents of citrus pith, mint, white flowers and minerals, with an exotic touch of passion fruit emerging with air. Juicy, shapely and precise, with vibrant flavors of grapefruit, tropical fruits and bitter quinine. Finishes with good grip, length and a hint of warmth. This deeply fruity wine will be very flexible with a variety of spicy Asian foods, especially Thai, Laotian, Vietnamese or Cambodian.”
