**90 pts** “Deep ruby black color. Aromas of honeyed dried cherries, chocolate covered, and eucalyptus. Satiny and round with a plush dry-yet fruity medium to full body. Wonderful integrated and mellow berry, citrus and spicy oak- flavor lingering on in the smooth tannin finish. A great sipper or pair with spicy dusk or ostrich.”
