**90 pts** “Sweet tannins, a soft texture (at least for the logic of a Cabernet wine) and lots of red fruit aromas and flavors as well as spices are found in this Cabernet that conveys its Maule origin, and though it might not has the elegance of Maipo Cabs it does express the warmth of the Pénahue area and all the juiciness of the wines sourced from that area.”

Supple and sweet on entry, then firmer in the mid-palate, with good ripeness to its bitter cherry and dark berry flavors. Repeats the cherry and tobacco notes on a persistent, gently chewy finish. This should repay a few years of patience.”
