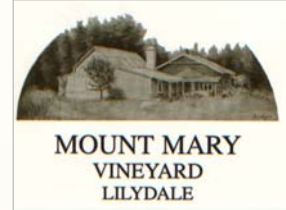




2010 MOUNT MARY CHARDONNAY

95 pts “Bright green-quartz; has the same varietal precision as that of the Pinot Noir; there isn't a hair out of place, yet this is in some ways a challenging wine with its grapefruit zest/grapefruit juice/white peach flavours anchored on its minerally acidity, oak merely a vehicle.”
