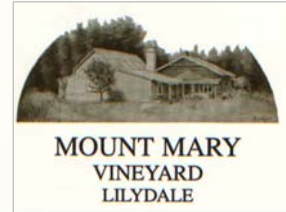




## 2010 MOUNT MARY PINOT NOIR
