90 pts “Light crimson-purple; the fragrant cassis-accented bouquet leads into a very well-balanced medium-bodied palate, the emphasis on the juicy redcurrant and blackcurrant fruit rather than oak or tannins; no need to delay.”

88 pts “This dark ruby colored red blend opens with a fragrant oak, bacon and black raspberry bouquet. On the palate, this wine is medium bodied, slightly acidic and juicy. The flavor profile is a ripe black raspberry with notes of integrated old oak and black plum. I also detected a touch of cranberry as well. The finish is dry and it mild sticky tannins and tingly acidity linger for quite some time. This wine will appeal to Zin fans and it will pair nicely with a big rack of messy barbecue ribs.”
