











2012 CHILCAS RESERVA SAUVIGNON BLANC

VINEYARD:

The Sauvignon Blanc grapes come from five-year-old vines from Chilensis' vineyards in the Casablanca Valley, located between Santiago and the country's main port of Valparaíso. The valley's maritime and diurnal temperature variation influences produce excellent conditions for Sauvignon Blanc that are reflected in the varietal's intense aromas and fresh flavors. Average yields are four tons per acre.

WINEMAKING:

The grapes were hand-picked during the first week of April and immediately transported to the winery for sorting and gentle de-stemming. Next, the fruit was cold macerated for eight to sixteen hours to maximize the intensity of the aromatics, followed by a cool ferment in stainless steel tanks lasting 21-28 days. The wine underwent a post-fermentation maceration and was stabilized for fifteen days and earth-filtered before bottling.

TASTING NOTES:

The 2011 Chilcas Reserva Sauvignon Blanc is pale silvery-green in color with an intense nose that stands out for its citrus aromas of grapefruit and mandarin orange. Characters of green apple and passion fruit also mingle with spice, floral and mineral aromas. The palate is citrus driven with a clean line of minerality, crisp acidity and a long, fruity finish.
