### 2013 CHILCAS SINGLE VINEYARD CABERNET SAUVIGNON

WINEMAKER:	Camilo Viani
REGION:	Colchagua Valley, Chile
VARIETALS:	93%Cabernet Sauvignon, $4%$ Cabernet Franc, $3%$ Petit Verdot
MATURATION:	18-20 months in 100% French oak (25% new barrels)
ANALYSIS:	14.3% alc/vol   TA: 5.20 g/L   pH: 3.60

#### VINEYARD:

The grapes for the Single Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon come from Chilcas' Nilahue vineyard in the Colchagua Valley (80 miles south of Santiago). The Colchagua Valley differs from other Chilean wine regions in that it runs between two spurs of the Andes Mountains, one to the north and one to the south, separated by an average distance of 22 miles. Summers are warm and dry with a significant day-night temperature variation which allows the grapes to ripen slowly with very good concentration and preservation of aromas and flavors. Winters are generally cold and rainy. Yields were three tons per acre.

#### WINEMAKING:

The grapes were hand-picked on April 10 and immediately transported to the winery for sorting and gentle de-stemming. Next, the fruit was cold macerated for three days followed by a warm ferment lasting 16 days and punch downs took place two to three times daily. The wine was then aged for up to 20 months in new and seasoned French oak barrels. The wine was lightly filtered before bottling.

#### TASTING NOTES:

The Single Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon is grown on rugged terrain on a rocky hillside, and the resulting wine is highly intense in both color and aroma. An expressive nose recalling red cherries and ripe strawberries with notes of pencil lead, black current and black licorice. The elegant texture on the palate is fresh and generous in red fruit and spice. This is an elegant and well-structured Cabernet that shows good expression now and for years to come.
