91 pts - Best of the Best by Variety "Bright color; complex, with lifted red fruit intermingles with dark, savoury and earthy notes and a hint of mint; fleshy on entry, the palate tightens up and delivers a slightly tarry and chewy finish. Grenache/Shiraz/Mourvedre."

90 pts "The blend is 50% Grenache, 40% Shiraz and 10% Mourvèdre, and it delivers a creamy mouthful of bright berry flavors. A hint of chocolate adds another dimension, while the mouthfeel is lush without being overly soft."
