92 pts “Deep, dark red. Expansive aromas of spicy red berries, candied cherry, white pepper and dried flowers. Classic grenache notes of sweet raspberry and cherry on the palate as well, with the floral note returning on the alluringly silky and extremely persistent finish. This would stack up nicely against some big-time southern Rhone wines.”

“Heathcote is a relatively cool area in Victoria; Georgia’s Paddock gets another leg up on the climate, sitting on a 1,000-foot rise facing northwest. Yet the 31-year-old vines, planted on their own roots, completely unirrigated and farmed biodynamically, mature slowly and produce a terrifically powerful red, velvet-dense in its fruit and red earth flavors. Like an orchestra playing fortissimo, it’s bold and loud but beautiful, every part in harmony, alcohol included.”
