VINEYARD:

Las Almas' fruit is from Chilcas' El Condor block located on its estate San Rafael vineyard in Maule Valley (124 miles south of Santiago and 12.5 miles from the Andes Mountain range). The valley is geographically diverse with a Mediterranean climate. Summers are warm and dry with a significant day-night temperature variation. The lack of rainfall after winter enables Chilcas to have a better control of the plant vigor, keeps the grape berries small, and helps the bunches to ripen uniformly. Yields were less than three tons per acre.

WINEMAKING:

The grapes were hand-picked between late April and mid May and immediately transported to the winery for sorting and gentle de-stemming. Next, the fruit was cold macerated for six days followed by a warm ferment lasting four to five weeks and punch downs took place one to two times daily. The wine matured for twenty-four months in French oak barrels.


TASTING NOTES:

Intensely aromatic on the nose, with ripe notes of cassis, cherry, blueberry and blackberry, all framed by delicate spicy touches and tobacco leaf aromas. Lush, juicy and expansive on the palate, the wine is nicely structured and shows great personality without compromising its gentle finesse. A vibrant acidity leads to a refreshing persistent finish with more spicy notes that reflect very well the typicity of the San Rafael terroir.
