88 pts “This very pale straw colored white wine from Bordeaux opens with a musty pear and light lemon bouquet. On the palate, this wine is light bodied, slightly acidic and mouthwatering. The flavor profile is a tart green apple with notes of minerality throughout. I also detected a touch of lime. The finish is dry and would pair well with steamed mussels.”
