89 pts “This tasting of 2008 Hazard Hill Shiraz was a tank sample that was ready for bottling. It gives a deep garnet-purple color and intense aromas of spicy blackberry, blueberry and freshly crushed black pepper. It's quite peppery on the palate with a medium to full body, medium to high acidity and a medium level of velvety tannins, finishing long.”

89 pts “This dark ruby colored Shiraz opens with a mild blackberry and black currant bouquet. On the palate, this wine is medium bodied, slightly acidic and juicy. The flavor profile is a blend of red currant, spicy blackberry and black pepper. I also detected some plum. The finish is dry and its mild tannins are slightly tingly. This wine is a nice everyday offering and would pair well with a pulled pork sandwich. Enjoy.”
