



## 2010 CHILCAS 'RED ONE'

### Review Summary



**92 pts** “A blend of one third Malbec, one third Cabernet Franc and one third Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Petit Verdot, this wine is crafted with a selection of grapes as well as barrels and is the second most important wine in the Chilcas portfolio preceded only by Las Almas, a Carmenère based wine. The 2010 Red One is a reflection of a cool year with its herbal aromas and red tart fruits; on the palate the wine reveals plenty of sweet flavors and also some leathery characters that lend complexity to the blend.”
