



2012 CHILCAS RESERVA PINOT NOIR

WINEMAKER: Camilo Viani
REGION: Maule Valley, Chile
VARIETALS: 100% Pinot Noir
MATURATION: 50% aged for 6 months in 100% French oak
ANALYSIS: 13.5% alc/vol | TA: 5.3 g/L | pH: 3.5

VINEYARD:

The grapes for the Reserva Pinot Noir come from 15-year-old vines from Chilcas' La Esperanza block located in its estate San Rafael vineyard in the Maule Valley (162 miles south of Santiago). The valley is geographically diverse with a Mediterranean climate. Summers are warm and dry with a significant day-night temperature variation. Winters are generally cold and rainy. Vigilant canopy management during the growing season led to a yield of just under three tons per acre.

WINEMAKING:

The 2012 harvest will be remembered as one of the warmest vintages over the past few years. The grapes were hand-picked March 19-30 and were immediately transported to the winery for sorting and gentle de-stemming. Next, the fruit was cold macerated for four days followed by a warm ferment lasting three weeks and punch downs took place two times daily. 50% of the wine was then aged for six months in 100% French oak barrels.

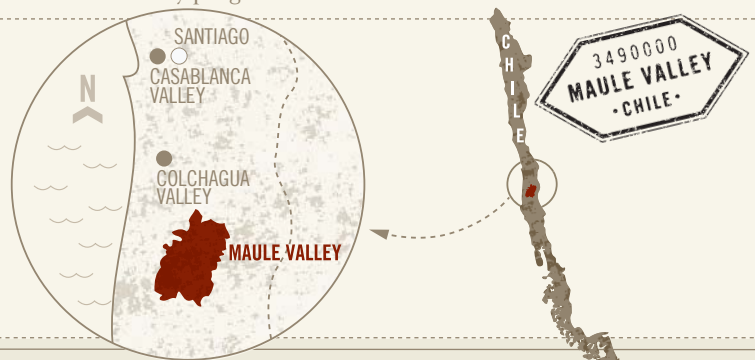
TASTING NOTES:

The Reserva Pinot Noir displays a bright, clean cherry-red color. There is a deep aromatic intensity that features aromas of fresh cherries and white strawberries, which lend great personality and a distinctive character to the wine. Gentle floral and earthy notes complement the fruity palate while its soft texture and medium volume are balanced by a fresh, persistent finish.
