



## 2007 KILIKANNOON BLOCKS ROAD CABERNET

### Review Summary



**91 pts** “Vivid ruby. High-pitched red berries and spices on the nose, with notes of pungent herbs and black tea adding complexity. Taut and focused on entry, gaining breadth in the mid-palate and offering sweet raspberry and cherry-vanilla flavors. The spicy note resonates on the long, energetic, impressively pure finish. This will age on its balance.”
