90+ pts “Deep garnet-purple in color, the 2010 Art Series Shiraz opens with aromas of warm black fruits – blackberries and black plums – with suggestions of cedar, black pepper, moss-covered bark and charcoal. Medium to full-bodied, the acidity is pretty full-on to begin, though towards the long finish the black fruits kick it into balance with a nice interplay of texture from medium level rounded tannins.”
