89 pts “Bright yellow-gold. Potent, lees-accented aromas of orchard fruits, orange and white flowers, with a gingery quality adding lift. Chewy, tightly focused pear and tangerine flavors flesh out with air and pick up a subtle anise quality. Closes stony and long, with lingering smokiness and a touch of bitter quinine.”
