



## 2012 LEEUWIN ESTATE SIBLINGS SAUVIGNON BLANC SEMILLON

### Review Summary



**90 pts** “This pale white gold colored white blend from the Margaret River is very good. It opens with a very fragrant ripe grapefruit bouquet with hints of wet stone and lime. On the palate, this wine is medium to full bodied, a tad acidic, viscous and mouthwatering. The flavor profile is a mineral infused mild grapefruit with notes of lime and white pepper. The finish is dry and its flavors linger and fade away nicely. This wine would be idea to pair with grilled swordfish kabobs.”
