### Review Summary



**90 pts – Very Good+** “This very dark ruby colored GSM opens with a mild black raspberry bouquet with a hint of blueberry. On the palate, this wine is medium bodied, slightly acidic and juicy. The flavor profile is blackberry with notes of oak and black pepper. I also detected a hint of plum. The finish is dry and its flavors and mild tannins linger slightly. This Aussie red blend will pair well with lentil soup with smoked ham.”
