


# 2010 d'ARENBERG THE NOBLE WRINKLED RIESLING

**92 pts – Very Good+** “This goldenrod colored dessert wine was the clear winner in our recent blind tasting. It opens with an apricot and honey like bouquet with a hint of peach, molasses and candle smoke. On the palate, this wine is full bodied, viscous, and pleasantly sweet. The flavor profile is a honey and mild apricot blend with a hint of brown sugar, golden raisin and fig. The finish remains sweet and fades away nicely. The panel suggested pairing this gem with Vermont sharp cheese and sliced green apples.”

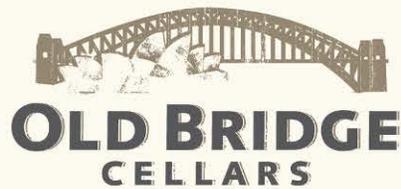

**90 pts** “The color is a beautiful glowing apricot/amber shade. The lush, ripe nose oozes honey, marmalade, and dried apricot, pear, and peach aromas, along with a subtle note of spice. Thick in the mouth, just short of cloying, it coats the palate with citrus honey and dried stone fruits. This is an ultra-ripe and sweet dessert wine, delicious by itself. It can also hold its own paired with seared foie gras on toast points drizzled with a bit of marmalade.”
