89 pts – Very Good “This pitch black colored Aussie red blend is a fruit bomb. It opens with a fragrant blackberry jam bouquet with hints of boysenberry. On the palate, this wine is full bodied, slightly acidic and rather juicy. The flavor profile is ripe blackberry with notes of plum & black licorice. I also detected hints of boysenberry, black pepper, and minerality. The finish is dry and its fruit flavors and gentle acidity linger well after the wine is gone. This fruit bomb would be perfect for a messy rack of Kansas City barbecue ribs.”
