90 pts “Dark ruby. Spicy, high-toned aromas of cherry, redcurrant and cracked pepper. Juicy and tightly focused on entry, then smooth and silky in the mid-palate, offering sweet red fruit flavors and a deeper licorice quality. A floral note emerges with aeration and carries through a long, supple, seemingly tannin-free finish. I'm sure this wine will reward patience but it drinks awfully well right now.”
