91 pts “Standout release under this label. Attractive mix of pepper and clovey savory elements with sweet cherry-plum fruit. Medium-bodied, well-shaped and well-formed. Tannin is modest and mannered but it draws back impressively through the wine.”

88 pts “Bright ruby. Dark berries, cherry and licorice on the pungent nose and in the mouth. A floral quality comes up with aeration, adding complexity to the wine’s dark fruit character. Shows a hint of bitter chocolate on the smoke-tinged finish, which is firmed by dusty, slow-building tannins. Give this one a little air time.”
