95 pts “Deeply colored, and showing vibrant aromas of black fruits, red licorice, sage, wet slate minerality and a generous dollop of spicy oak; the palate is thickly textured on entry, yet remains light on its feet, and whilst some warmth from high alcohol is noticeable, it merely complements the hedonistic fruit on offer.”

Broad and alluringly sweet dark fruit compote flavors stain the palate and are lifted and sharpened by juicy acidity. Floral pastille and spicecake qualities come up on the subtly tannic finish, which lingers with superb tenacity.”

On the palate, this wine is full bodied, nicely balanced and smooth as silk. The flavor profile is a mild boysenberry with nicely integrated minerality. I also detected hints of faint oak, black cherry and dark chocolate. The finish is dry and its moderate tannins stick around for a good length of time. I would pair this tasty Shiraz with a pan-seared New York strip steak.”
