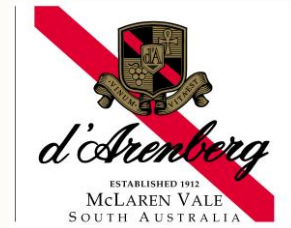




2011 d'ARENBERG THE OTHER SIDE Review Summary
