93 pts “The Clare Valley doesn't always come up with the right answers with Cabernet Sauvignon, but in this vintage did so in spades. The wine is full-bodied, with a classic array of black fruits and savory/earthy tannins to provide texture and structure; the oak handling has also been spot on.”
