91 pts – BEST BUY “Based in Mount Barker, Plantagenet produces this wine from vineyards in Great Southern. It’s a lean, spicy Shiraz with clean lines, focused by mineral-infused tannins. There’s an herbal greenness, the scent of karri forest, the bite of green olives, the spice of cracked green peppercorns, all carried with moderate weight on a graceful texture. A by-the-case buy.”

88 pts – Very Good “This ruby colored Shiraz from Australia is a nice quaffer. It opens with a faint red raspberry bouquet with a hint of leather and blueberry. On the palate, this wine is full bodied, balanced, smooth and very easy to drink. The flavor profile is a tasty mild black cherry with notes of gentle plum and faint blueberry. The finish is dry and its flavors fade away nicely. This is a perfect Shiraz to pair with meat lasagna or your favorite brick oven pizza.”
