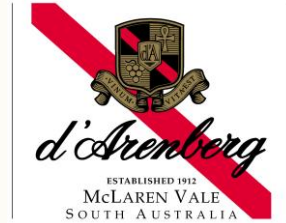




2013 d'ARENBERG THE STUMP JUMP WHITE

Review Summary



88 pts “Bright straw color. Dried citrus fruits, peach pit and beeswax and the spice-accented nose. Picks up a floral quality with air and offers gently sweet pit and orchard fruit flavors that provide good palate coverage. Smooth and round on the finish, with a lingering note of peach nectar. I'd serve this plush wine with a spicy Thai curry or salty charcuterie.”

87 pts – Very Good “This light yellow colored blend opens with a faint apple and light honey bouquet. On the palate, this wine is medium bodied, crisp and acidic. The flavor profile is a mineral infused tangerine with notes of stonefruit and a hint of mild pineapple towards the end. The finish is dry and its flavors and acidity are nicely prolonged. This wine would pair well with Quiche Lorraine appetizers.”
