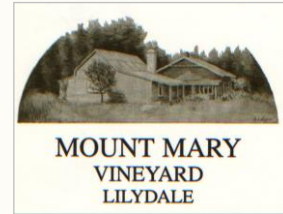




2012 MOUNT MARY CHARDONNAY

Review Summary



96 pts – Best of Chardonnay 2015 “Pale but brilliant quartz-green; the bouquet and palate reveal a wine of ultimate refinement, with laser-like clarity and precision of its flavors; while barrel-fermented, it is the fruit that drives the very long palate, bolstered by perfectly weighted acidity; the flavors span white fleshed stone fruits, a touch of cashew, finishing with grapefruity-acidity.”

94 pts “Bright yellow. Pungent smoke- and mineral-tinged orchard fruit and melon aromas show very good clarity and pick up a sexy floral nuance with air. Chewy, focused and pure, offering intense pear and honeysuckle flavors along with suggestions of tarragon and vanilla. Exudes an exotic seashell quality on the incisive finish, which clings with outstanding tenacity and focus. Quite rich for this bottling, which does not go through malolactic fermentation.”
