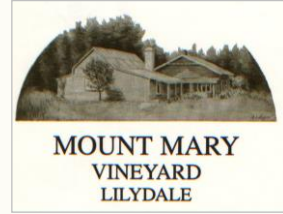




## 2012 MOUNT MARY PINOT NOIR

### Review Summary



**97 pts – Best of Pinot Noir 2015** “Bright, clear crimson-purple; an immaculately made pinot, immediately reflecting the special qualities of the site, the age (40+ years) of the vines, and the great vintage; the flowery, perfumed red-berried bouquet leads into an exquisitely flavored and structured palate, making the words 'elegance' and 'finesse' seem like clichés. This is a great Pinot Noir, even by the exalted standards of Mount Mary.”

**93 pts** “Vivid red. Sexy, Asian spice-accented raspberry and cherry scents are complemented by deeper notes of licorice, black tea, rose and musky underbrush. On the palate, sweet red and dark berry flavors are complicated by vanilla, spicecake and bitter chocolate, with a smoky nuance gaining strength with aeration. Picks up energy and minerality on the finish, leaving behind intense black raspberry and floral pastille notes. This suave Pinot benefits significantly from being open a while.”
