88+ pts "Bright red. Spicy red berry aromas show good clarity and a hint of rhubarb. Clean and tightly wound, showing good thrust to its bitter cherry and redcurrant flavors, which slowly gain flesh with air. The firm-edged finish lingers with good spicy tenacity and building tannins."
