97 pts “Excellent color; the cooler climate of the Blewitt Springs/Blewitt Sands district gives this wine exceptional intensity, with a strong savory/spicy carpet for the primary grenache fruit flavors; the tannins also play an important role, oak merely a vehicle to bring the wine to the point where it is ready to bottle.”

92 pts “Brilliant ruby. Intense, highly perfumed aromas of candied red berries, floral oils, Asian spices and white pepper. Juicy raspberry and cherry flavors put on weight with air and show very good clarity. Spreads out nicely on the finish, which lingers with excellent tenacity and smooth, fully absorbed tannins. I find this sexy, emphatically fruity grenache highly appealing now but it also has the depth to age.”
